The BC Generations Project will help researchers learn more about how environment, lifestyle and genes contribute to cancer and chronic diseases. It's part of the Canadian Partnership for Tomorrow, a national initiative to collect health information and biological samples from 300,000 Canadians.

By pooling and linking information collected across the country, we will create a research resource that can be used over the next 25 years for thousands of studies in cancer and chronic disease. Results from these studies will be critical to guide future disease prevention programs.

The BC Generations Project is a BC Cancer Agency project, funded by the Canadian Partnership Against Cancer and the BC Cancer Foundation.

If you are 35–69 years old and living in BC, you're eligible to participate in the BC Generations Project.



Participation

If you would like to participate in the BC Generations Project, simply contact us. Participation is completely voluntary and we strictly protect the confidentiality of our participants and their information.

Our process allows us to obtain information, specimens and physical measurements with the least inconvenience to you. We will send you a package that includes a consent form to explain all aspects of the study. We will also ask you to complete a questionnaire about your health, lifestyle, and history of diseases. We may also ask you for a blood and a urine sample.



The Project offers two enrolment options. Participants can complete the registration package and return it by mail, or they can visit a BC Generations Project clinic. In addition to its clinic in Vancouver, the Project hopes to schedule clinics in major cities throughout British Columbia.

Protecting your privacy

The security and confidentiality of data are top priorities for the BC Generations Project. We operate stringent security measures, which include sophisticated computer controls and building access systems.



The samples and information you provide to the BC Generations Project are stored anonymously, with all identifying information removed. This anonymized data is only released for ethically and scientifically approved research into the causes and treatment of disease.
